

DNOW Covenant

Because I desire to grow through the opportunity of DNOW, I stand in agreement with and will willingly submit to the following guidelines. I understand that violation of these guidelines could result in my immediate return home without a refund or reimbursement of any money.

- 1) Students must dress appropriately with Christian modesty in mind. No clothing will be permitted that promotes tobacco products, alcoholic products or suggestive messages.
- 2) Students must not use personal vehicles for any reason, or leave DNOW events without first contacting Dustin and letting your group leader know as well. You CANNOT drive your car, nor can anyone ride with you during DNOW unless you have permission from Dustin and your parents. THIS MUST BE APPROVED BEFORE THE BEGINNING OF THE WEEKEND.
- 3) Do not disturb those who actually want to sleep.
- 4) Do not leave your host home for **ANY** reason unless you have gotten permission from Dustin **AND** your group leader **AND** your parents. You cannot leave to get food, run errands or to play a joke on someone. Help us keep you safe. Hit the "Pause" button on your impulses. Stay in your host homes and focus on Jesus.
- 5) DNOW students must submit to the direction and supervision of their leader and host home. They care about you and love you. Trust them this weekend.
- 6) Cell phones must always be on silent or turned off completely during times of worship and Bible Study.
- 7) Fireworks, firearms, knives or any other kind of weapon, drugs, alcohol, vaping or any form of tobacco are not allowed.
- 8) Public Displays of Affection are not allowed during DNOW.
- 9) Your host homes and hosts will be treated with respect. Take care of the home that God has provided for the weekend and be kind and respectful to your hosts. Be aware that you are responsible for any damages that you may cause.
- 10) You are expected to attend and participate in all scheduled services and activities. If you are too sick to participate in DNOW services and activities, you are too sick to remain at DNOW.

Your signature indicates that you and your parents know that if you fail to use good judgement and common sense in following the rules listed above, you will be dismissed from DNOW and returned home with no refund or reimbursement of any money.
